

Alessandro Giorgi is an Italian military historian, researcher and author. His focus is centered on World War 2, Vietnam, Cold War clandestine operations and Italian military operations after WW2. He was born in Milan, Italy, on 25 June, 1960. After military service in the 11th Infantry Battalion "Casale", Italian Army, he graduated in Economics at the Università Luigi Bocconi in Milan with a thesis on the Italian defense industry. Having followed a sales and marketing career, at present he is General Manager for a multi-national corporation. "Chronology of World War II 1939-1945" is the English language edition of "Cronaca della Seconda Guerra Mondiale 1939-1945", published by Editoriale Lupo, Vicchio, Florence, 2013. He is also the author of "Cronaca della Guerra del Vietnam 1961-1975", published in 2016 by Luca Poggiali Editore, Florence.
