

## Call for Papers NAM: Vol. 4, Issue 14 (spring 2023) Fourth issue of Ancient Military History

We are inviting submissions of original papers and book reviews to be considered for publication in the next issue of NAM, which will be published in spring 2023. Papers should deal with warfare in the ancient world, with particular attention to the Greek and Roman worlds, and may cover different aspects: tactics; strategy; armour; political, economic and social aspects of war; memory of conflict and commemoration; anthropology of conflict.

Submissions can be made in Italian, English, French, German, or Spanish; they should be no less than 6 000 and no more than 8000 words in length and should be accompanied by an abstract of 100-250 words in English. NAM is an **open access, double blind** peer-reviewed journal which publishes scholarly articles in the field of Ancient Military History. It was founded in November 2019 by Virgilio Ilari and Giovanni Brizzi and is the result of forty years of "militant" experience in the field of history of war, military historiography and strategic studies, which began in the last decade of the Cold War. One issue a year is devoted to War in Antiquity and publishes articles on a wide range of aspects (tactics; strategy; armour; political, economic and social aspects of war; memory of conflict and commemoration; anthropology of conflict). So far NAM has published 130 articles and 106 book reviews (5,200 pages), including 36 and 21 of Ancient Military History.
